



Monitor Measures

Is the lace monitor under threat within the forest of Brewongle? Students will work scientifically to determine the ability of the forest to support a population of lace monitors.

Setting the Scene: Google Earth, what ecosystem are we investigating? Video introduction features our local lace monitor.

Abiotic / Biotic Data Collection: Students collect physical and chemical data to assess the health of the forest.

Nest Box & Natural Shelters: Using specialised cameras students view live feeds on a portable screen to determine the current status of shelter sites at Brewongle.

Water Quality Analysis: Is the water hole where the lace monitor is known to frequent of an acceptable standard?

Scats & Tracks: Document and classify the animals present by identifying their scats and / or tracks.
