



2 Day Leadership Camp and Award – For Primary Schools

This unique blend of team building, communication, problem solving and outdoor challenges is a camp for leadership students in your school. This program is the first step in the Brewongle Leadership Award – students can embark on environmental, community and school projects back at school to receive their awards in Term 4.

A two day camping program can include activities like:

Initiative / Team Building Challenges: Master our ping pong challenge, magic carpet squares and blindfold course.

Kayaking or Adventure Navigation: Students will be challenged to master kayaks (maximum student numbers 30) on the Hawkesbury River or GPS units to navigate our Eco Challenge course on land.

Mission Codebreak: Use GPS units, compasses and walkie talkies to find and solve all the hidden problems. Radio in your discoveries to a specialist code breaking team at base camp!

iPad Movie Making: Storyboard, rehearse and film a short film documenting how you will implement leadership and complete your award back at school.

Boomerang Throwing and the Waterball Game: A short walk to our local oval opens up a world of fun! Learn to throw a boomerang like a Darug hunter and try to stay dry in our water pistol habitat game!
