

What to Bring to Brewongle EEC

Students are required to bring the following to camp:

- **Morning Tea & Lunch** for first day (see attached Low Litter Lunch flyer)
- **Water bottle** - with child's name on it
- **Sunscreen, sunhat** & insect repellent (the mozzies may be around)
- Raincoat - medium length (parkas are not waterproof)
- 2 pairs sneakers / joggers - must fully enclose the feet (1 pair is for kayaking)
- Small back pack - to carry water bottle, sunscreen, raincoat, warm jumper etc. for day's activities.
- Garbage bag for dirty clothes
- **Warm sleeping bag, pillow** and pillow case.
- Long pants and shorts
- T-shirts or long sleeve shirts - no 'crop' tops
- **Warm jumper, polar fleece, sloppy joe or jacket**
- Pyjamas
- Underwear, socks, beanie, hanky.
- Toiletries - soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant etc.
- Towel and face washer
- Tea towel (students could be required to do duties at certain times)
- Thongs for showering only
- **Torch** and batteries (a must) - helps with going to bathroom at night.
- Pens, pencils and coloured pencils
- Cameras permitted at own risk
- **NO valuables** ie; jewellery, mobile phones, radios or electronic games.
- All medication should be clearly labelled, student name & dosage explained and given to teacher before departing school.
- **NO Chewing Gum** to be brought to camp

Kayakers - your clothes and shoes will get dirty and wet!!!! So pack old clothes!

- Board shorts/shorts.
- Rash vest or t.shirt (preferably long sleeves)
- Old joggers/shoes or wet suit booties (shoes **MUST** be worn)
- Beach towel

Students will be required to walk approx 100 metres down a bush track with steps to the camp area with their bags. (**Bags with wheels are NOT recommended**)

It is advisable to bring old, comfortable, protective clothing to camp.

Note: Our gift shop is now closed. Students will not need to bring any money on camp.

To reduce the amount of rubbish on your visit we ask that students try not to bring the following :

- Pre Packed, portion controlled packets (eg. chips, cheese and bikkie combo's)
- Lollies in individual wrappers.
- Drinks in throw away cartons (poppers) with straws. (Those rectangular boxes create 3 pieces of rubbish each)



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
